What are the dates of camp?

What is the cost of camp?

- \$200 for Campers, Jr. Counselors, & Counselors

What is the age range of a Camper?

- Campers are those who have completed 3rd grade—Those who have just completed 8th grade

Who can be a Junior Counselor?

Who can be a Counselor?
