April 1-7

Focus: Church Replanters UPG: Uyghur Muslims

And I tell you that you are Peter (rock), and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it. Matthew 16:18

1	Read thru the Bible	Focus Prayer Points	Pray for Uyghur Muslims
	Apr 1: 1Sam 18-20	Pray for church replanters and the existing congregation as changes are made.	Pray for Christian leaders to arise from among the Uyghurs.
	Apr 2: 1Sam 21-24	Pray for church replanters and the church body to have a willingness to change and reach the lost.	Pray for the Chinese Church to hear and obey God's call to reach the Uyghurs.
	Apr 3: 1Sam 25-27	Pray for the church replanters to have patient endurance when things are difficult.	Pray for open doors for Christ followers to be granted access to the Xinjiang region.
	Apr 4: 1Sam 28-31	Pray that church replanters will have a strong marriage and family.	Pray for Uyghurs being detained and persecuted to meet Jesus in their isolation and suffering.
	<u>Apr 5: 2Sam 1-3</u>	Ask God for church replanters to have wisdom on what to do with church buildings. Pray for wisdom as churches open up their facilities to the community.	Pray for those in detention camps.
	Apr 6: 2Sam 4-7	Pray that church replanters would find people of peace in the church community.	Pray that Uyghur Muslims encounter Jesus when they cry out to Allah in distress.
	Apr 7: 2Sam 8-12	Pray that church replanters see transformed lives and growing disciples.	Pray for the detention camps to close and oppression against Uyghurs to end.



#### Learn about Your Uyghur Muslim Neighbors

The core beliefs and practices of Islam are called its "Five Pillars:"

- 1. **Profession of Faith** (*shahada*). "There is no god but Allah, and Muhammad is the Messenger of Allah"
- 2. **Prayer** (*salat*). Muslims pray facing the city of Mecca five times a day: at dawn, noon, mid-afternoon, sunset, and after dark.
- 3. **Alms** (*zakat*). Islamic law requires that Muslims donate a fixed portion of their income to community members in need.
- 4. **Fasting** (*sawm*). During the daylight hours of Ramadan, the ninth month of the Islamic calendar, all healthy adult Muslims are required to abstain from food and drink.
- 5. **Pilgrimage** (*hajj*). Every Muslim whose health and finances permit it must make at least one visit to Mecca, their holy city, in present-day Saudi Arabia.

	Apr 8: 2Sam 13-15	Hosanna! Let's praise God like the Palm Sunday crowds and honor Jesus, our Prince of Peace	Pray for wisdom for Nepal's leaders
	Apr 9: 2Sam 16-18	Let's invite Jesus to overturn the money tables and anything else that distracts us from Him in our lives	Pray for grace and peace for the people of Nepal.
	Apr 10: 2Sam 19-21	Today let's ask God to increase our faith and boldness in Him, so that we are not afraid to ask Him to move the mountains in our lives	Pray for discernment and wisdom for believers as they live out their faith in Jesus.
	Apr 11: 2Sam 22-24	Pray for a servant's heart, like Jesus showed when He washed His disciples' feet	Pray for conversion of the high-caste Hill Brahim and Chhetri (Rajput). They represent 30.9% of Nepal's population and play a dominant role in shaping it.
	Apr 12: 1King 1-2	Pray for the ability to trust God's plan in the midst of pain and to be able to say sincerely, "Your will be done"	Pray against the sex-trafficking of Nepali girls and for the Christian ministries attempting to rescue these children.
	Apr 13: 1King 3-5	Today let's ask God for the grace to pick up our cross daily and follow Jesus, wherever He leads	Pray for the effective transfer of Christian (Nepalese) leadership between the generations
	Apr 14: 1King 6-7	Thank Jesus for His perfect sacrifice on our behalf. Thank Him that there is now "no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus."	Pray that Nepalese Christian leaders learn to function as tentmakers, and that congregations would learn to support their pastors as much as they are able.



#### Learn about Your Nepalese Neighbors

Many Nepalese immigrate to the United States in search of educational and employment opportunities. Because of Nepal's inadequate educational system, wealthy Nepalese send their children to the West for schooling. Many Nepalese students apply for work permits and eventually become citizens of the United States. However, acclimation to life in the U.S. is often a difficult process.

Many Nepalese customs and beliefs are heavily influenced by Buddhist or Hindu values. Many Nepalese American women continue to wear the Tika, a red sandalwood dot pasted on the forehead, as an indication of marriage. The word "Namaste" is a common expression. It is used for greetings such as "hello," "good morning," and "good night."

Focus: Resurrection UPG: Afghani Muslims

	Apr 15: 1King 8-9	Pray to have a passion for the lost. Pray that believers will be brought into their lives, and they would show love, patience, and grace.	Pray for the Afghan believers to grow in maturity in their walk with the Lord and share the gospel with others
	Apr 16: 1King 10-11	Ask God for a passion for the hurting. Pray for the many families affected by Covid-19, racial injustice, and victims of the mass shootings.	Pray for the over 60,000 Afghans in the Bay Area, that God would soften their hearts to the gospel of Jesus
	Apr 17: 1King 12-14	Pray for a passion for the rich. Pray that their hearts would be prepared to receive the Word.	Pray for peace through Jesus to come to Afghanistan after 40 years of war in the country
	Apr 18: 1King 15-17	Pray for a passion to reach the poor. Pray for children affected by malnutrition. Pray for the many families who cannot find work.	Pray for the over 2.5 million Afghan refugees in the world! Pray that God will mobilize his church around the world to reach out to their Afghan neighbors
	Apr 19: 1King 18-20	Pray for a passion to make disciples. Pray for the discipleship micro groups of 3-4 people to multiply and equip disciple makers.	Pray for unity in Christ for the worldwide Afghan church that they might reach their own people together. Pray for a pure gospel message to be proclaimed
	Apr 20: 1King 21-22	Ask God for a passion for cross-cultural missions. Pray that God would burden your heart for an unreached people group.	Pray for the many remote ministries that are designed to reach Afghans via the internet, television, and radio.
	Apr 21: 2King 1-3	Pray for a passion to abide in Christ. Pray that you would delight in God's Word and pray without ceasing.	Pray for the many Afghan "secret believers" who are isolated from other believers, that they might find fellowship and not fear.



## Learn about Your Afghan Neighbors

Multiple sources say that the Bay Area, especially Fremont, hosts the largest Afghan population in the US. There is a cultural and commercial district called Little Kabul in Fremont, which serves as a hub for Afghans.

The most common form of greeting among Afghan women is hugging and kissing 3 times; men are more likely to put their hand over their chest and/or shake hands. Physical contact with a person of the opposite gender is avoided, except with close family.

Hospitality is important to the culture, and visitors are treated with much respect. Meals are often served while sitting on the floor. Zabihah.com lists local halal eating establishments and the kind of ethnic food served at each, making it easy to find restaurants owned and managed by people from Afghanistan.

	Apr 23: 2King 6-8	Pray for Chris and Cathie Smith as they equip disciple-makers. Pray for the Smith family. Pray for their three children Caylee, Cayleb, and Caytlin.	Ask that God will supernaturally answer Hindus in their search, and many would turn to follow Christ as the one and only Truth.
	Apr 24: 2King 9-11	Pray for Chris and Cathie Smith as they equip disciple-makers. Pray that the GCA south churches would focus on making disciples.	Pray that in their search to know 'god', Hindus will come to understand the triune God of heaven
	Apr 25: 2King 12-14	Pray that the GCA south churches would encourage each other.	Pray that Hindus will come to understand that God has given them eternal life only through His Son.
	Apr 26: 2King 15-17	Pray that the pastors/leaders would train others in the church. Pray for the Great Commission Training Institute summer classes	Pray that Hindus will understand that Jesus Christ is the only WAY to truth and reality
	Apr 27: 2King 18-19	Pray for unity within all our GCA churches.	Ask that many Hindus would start exploring the Bible and that their hearts and minds would be opened to Jesus
	Apr 28: 2King 20-22	Pray for the Hispanic pastors/leaders. Pray that God would bring many Hispanics to faith and our GCA Hispanic churches would grow in number and disciples.	Pray that Hindus will become hungry and thirsty to have a personal relationship with the living God in heaven.



#### Learn about Your Hindi-speaking Hindu Neighbors

Hindi refers to a language and Hindu refers to a religion. Around 80% of India identifies as Hindu, and Hinduism is the third largest religion in the world. It includes a wide range of beliefs, ideas, practices, philosophies, and traditions, and signifies a way of life. Hinduism does not teach belief in one god, nor in one prophet. For most Hindus, there is a unifying belief in Dharma, which includes certain duties, laws, conduct, and virtues that become essentially a right way of living.

There are 42,000 Hindu speakers in Santa Clara County that are five years and older. Many are short term workers and students who will return to India in a few years. Those who stay have ongoing relationships with family and friends in their home country. Most are able to speak English, so English speakers of many backgrounds can reach out to them.

#### Learn about Your Punjabi-speaking Sikh Neighbors

About 148,000 Punjabi speakers live in California. Almost 30,000 of those reside in the Bay Area. Most have roots in the Punjab region of northern India and Pakistan, where Sikhism is practiced by the majority.

There are five Sikh religious symbols: Kesh (uncut hair), Kara (a steel bracelet), Kanga (a wooden comb), Kaccha (cotton underwear) and Kirpan (steel sword). Sikhs (especially men) who wear turbans as part of their religious heritage are sometimes mistaken for Muslims or Arabs, but they are neither. Sikhism is a completely different world religion and is not related to Islam at all. Most people you see wearing turbans in California are Sikh. They assemble and worship in gurdwaras, which means "door to the guru." There are many gurdwaras in Bay Area cities.
